



# Wolves In The Walls

## Synopsis:

English: The picture book, *Wolves in the Walls*, is the stimulus for this theme. Children develop their understanding of figurative language and cohesion to write a narrative based on the story.

Art: Children use drawing and painting to suggest mood to emulate an illustration from the book.

## Art

Media & Materials	<p>In drawing, use a range of pencils to begin to develop personal style, drawing on the work of other artists for inspiration</p> <p>In painting, use watercolours to suggest mood</p> <p>Capture artistic process in sketch book</p>
Significant Artists	<p>Understand how great artists, architects and designers contribute to the culture, creativity and wealth of our nation</p> <p>Communicate ideas and comment on artworks using artistic language</p>
Vocabulary	<p>Use range of artistic vocabulary to communicate ideas, discuss and evaluate work/other artworks eg tactile, influence, captivate, emulate</p>
Skills	<p>Improve mastery of art/design techniques with wide range of materials</p>

## Writing

Language & Vocabulary	<p>Become familiar with the language of writing eg figurative language, imagery, style and effect</p> <p>Select appropriate language and vocabulary to reflect their understanding of audience and purpose</p> <p>Develop characters, settings and atmosphere using language and vocabulary from reading/books</p> <p>Use dictionaries (and thesauruses) to check meaning of new words/language</p>
Plan, Draft, Edit & Evaluate	<p>Use dictionaries to check the spelling and meaning of words</p> <p>Identify audience and purpose of writing</p> <p>Note and develop initial ideas drawing on reading</p> <p>Select appropriate grammar and punctuation and understand how these can change/enhance meaning</p> <p>Assess effectiveness of own and others' writing</p> <p>Propose changes to grammar, punctuation and vocabulary to enhance meaning/effectiveness</p>
Grammar & Punctuation	<p>Use expanded noun phrases for accuracy</p> <p>Build cohesion within a paragraph</p>
Text Structure & Features	<p>Use a wide range of devices to build cohesion within and across paragraphs</p>
